### PUBLIC

<b>REAL IDENTITY</b> A Living Breathing Man or Woman <i>with</i> substance, rights and freedoms.	<b>LEGAL IDENTITY</b> A Fiction or Corporation <i>without</i> substance, rights and freedoms.
<b>SOVEREIGN</b> This is not a title, but a status. Your status is of supreme authority over your life.	<b>LEGAL TITLE</b> Titles like Person, Resident, Citizen, Tax payer, Mr & Mrs, lowers your status losing authority.
<b>COURT OF LAW</b> Your Court is the Supreme Court, where you make the law for those wishing to enter it.	<b>COURT OF LEGISLATION</b> You have lost all your rights and freedoms, and are under the control of another's court.
<b>LAWFUL JURISDICTION</b> You have full and complete control over the Jurisdiction of your court and your life.	<b>LEGAL JURISDICTION</b> Your public title gives others full and complete jurisdiction over you. All your rights are lost.
<b>YOUR MASTER</b> No one is your master, no one owns you, for if they did you would be a slave.	<b>YOUR MASTER</b> Your master is the state or corporation. They own your legal title. You are a slave.
<b>OBLIGATIONS</b> You only have obligations to contracts you have freely agreed upon.	<b>OBLIGATIONS</b> You are now obligated to obey the commands of others, who dictate your orders.
<b>MONEY</b> Money has real value, such as gold and silver. You choose the money in your court.	<b>FIAT CURRENCY</b> You are a bonded slave and must pay back another mans debt.
<b>TAX</b> Payment of tax is an offer; it is your right to accept or to decline.	<b>TAX PAYER</b> Accepting the title Tax Payer means you are now obligated to pay, without refusal.
<b>FINES</b> You cannot be subject to any fines, without lawful due process, in a court of law.	<b>FINES</b> As a public title, you are an employee subject to fines from the administration.
<b>REGULATIONS</b> Regulations must be accepted in a contract; it is a crime if they are imposed upon you.	<b>REGULATIONS</b> Your legal identity accepts all regulations and consequences of not obeying.
<b>PERMITS</b> No one has authority over you; therefore a permit is not required. It is your life.	<b>PERMITS</b> Your authority has been given to the one who controls you; you must ask permission to live.
<b>LICENCE</b> You do not need a licence to exercise your rights, only to use the rights of others.	<b>PUBLIC LICENCE</b> Your own property and rights have been given away; you now need a licence to use them.
<b>PRIVATE REGISTRATION</b> Your rights are reserved; you have consented to information cataloguing only.	<b>PUBLIC REGISTRATION</b> Your rights are gone; your property has become the possession of the state.
